# BRRRETON BAY Polar Bear Plunge FAOs

#### Q: How old must you be to be a Breton Bay Plunger?

A: There are no age restrictions, but participants age 12 or under should be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Young children can participate safely and parents are expected to use their best judgment. **Lifeguards NOT on duty**.

### Participants plunge at their own risk.

# Q: What should I wear to the Plunge?

A: Pretty much whatever you want. Recommended Plunge attire is swimsuit. Footwear is highly recommended as it will protect your feet from sharp objects and the very cold beach sand allow you to enter and exit the water faster. Wetsuits are discouraged (real polar bears don't use them) but crazy costumes aren't.

### Q: How far do I have to go into the water?

A: Its up to you. Some may go all the way under, while others go ankle-deep. As long as you get wet, you are a Breton Bay Polar Bear Plunger!

# Q: Where/how do I make a charitable contribution on Plunge day?

A: Contributions to St. Mary's Caring Soup Kitchen can be sent directly to St. Mary's Caring or can be made at the event itself. Plungers, spectators, and party-goers alike are encouraged to make either a monetary or canned food contribution. There is no minimum amount, anything is appreciated.

# Q: Can I still attend the Post-Plunge Party even if I don't Plunge?

A: Absolutely! Even if you can't make the plunge itself, please join in the fun at the party and vice versa. There will be a roaring fire to warm your chilly bones and plenty of good friends & music! The Avenmar Clubhouse will be open when the plunge ends and the party will start as wet plungers return from the beach.
